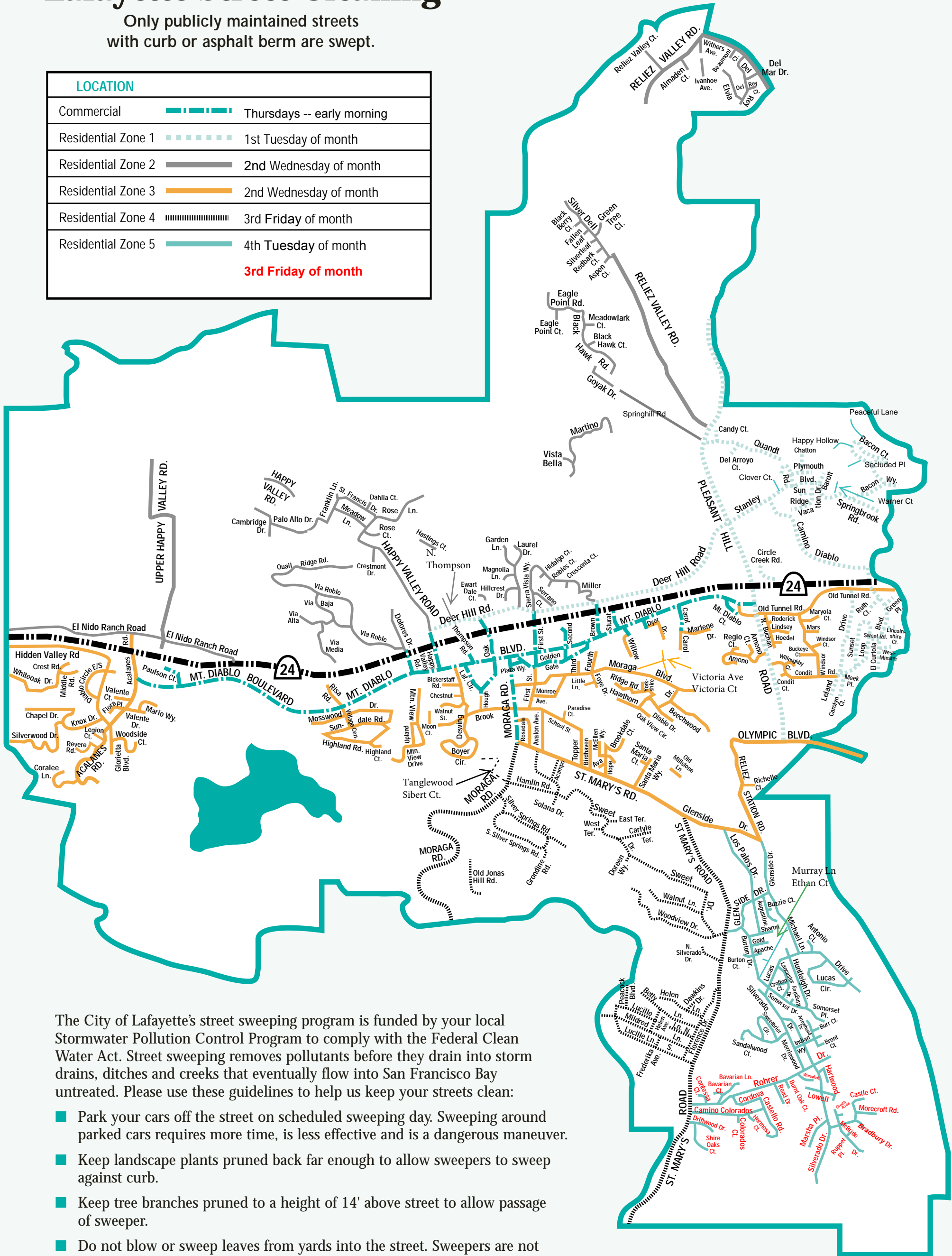


Lafayette Street Cleaning

Only publicly maintained streets with curb or asphalt berm are swept.

LOCATION	
Commercial	Thursdays -- early morning
Residential Zone 1	1st Tuesday of month
Residential Zone 2	2nd Wednesday of month
Residential Zone 3	2nd Wednesday of month
Residential Zone 4	3rd Friday of month
Residential Zone 5	4th Tuesday of month 3rd Friday of month



The City of Lafayette's street sweeping program is funded by your local Stormwater Pollution Control Program to comply with the Federal Clean Water Act. Street sweeping removes pollutants before they drain into storm drains, ditches and creeks that eventually flow into San Francisco Bay untreated. Please use these guidelines to help us keep your streets clean:

- Park your cars off the street on scheduled sweeping day. Sweeping around parked cars requires more time, is less effective and is a dangerous maneuver.
- Keep landscape plants pruned back far enough to allow sweepers to sweep against curb.
- Keep tree branches pruned to a height of 14' above street to allow passage of sweeper.
- Do not blow or sweep leaves from yards into the street. Sweepers are not equipped to pick up large piles of leaves left in the street.
- Only publicly maintained streets with curb or asphalt berm are swept.

If you see someone dumping into a storm drain, call 1-800-NO DUMPING or City offices. Record as much information about the incident and parties involved as possible (take photos). If you have household hazardous wastes to dispose of, please call 1-800-646-1431.
